

Learning in the Leaves

Flat Tarp Shelter



Stage 1: This shelter is one of the easiest to create once you have found a location. Ideally you want to try and find an area with four trees located in a square. It doesn't need to be perfect as different length ropes can be used. You then simply attach each corner of your tarp to one of the trees.



Stage 2: When positioning your tarp there are two options.

Flat Tarp



Easily set up, and when put at a height creates lots of room evenly under the shelter. However rain can easily collect on the tarp creating pools that need to be emptied.

Angled Tarp



Again Easily set up, one end of the shelter is ideal for equipment as lower. The angle helps the rain to run off the shelter. If set up tight enough, pools will not form.
