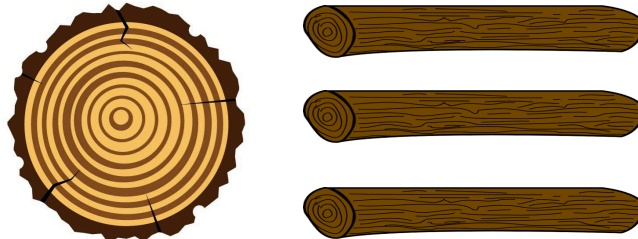

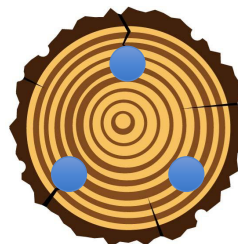
Making a Stool



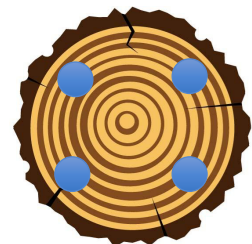
Stage 1: Firstly, you will need to collect your materials. You will need a narrow slice of a wide log to act as the seat. Then you will need 3-4 lengths sticks up to 12 inches in length and 1-2 inches thick. Ensure all the legs are the same length. These materials are best prepared using a bow saw.



Stage 2: Into the base drill three holes using a hand auger. The auger acts as a drill, put a stick through the top, place the end where you want to drill and start turning. Avoid putting your hands close to the auger as your fingers can get pinched between the hole and stick your turning.

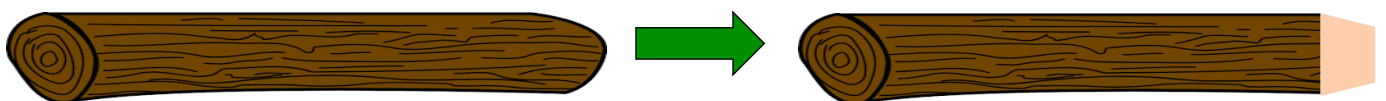


Three Legs

Stage 3: Shape the ends of your sticks using a sheath knife to a size which will fit onto the holes you have drilled. Remember to work with your knife to the side, with the blade facing away from you.



Stage 3: Use a mallet or log to hammer the shaped ends into the holes in the seat. You may need to adjust lengths of legs to make the stool stable.
